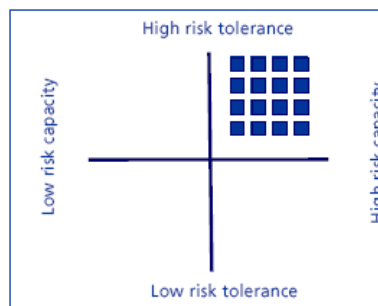
### Investment universe

The investment group invests globally in equities, bonds, real estate, mortgages and alternative investments within the respective valid guidelines within the scope of the Swiss Federal Law on Occupational Retirement, Survivors' and Disability Pension Plans (BVG/BVV2).

### Investment process

The main purpose of the combination of traditional asset classes and non-traditional asset classes, which are historically only slightly correlated, is to optimize the return with heavy use of equities and significant fluctuations in value:

Target fluctuation reserves: 12-14% (minimum at beginning: 8%)



### Manager

Unlike the majority of competitors, the Zurich investment foundation does not exclusively cooperate with a single asset manager. With the aid of an independent and clearly structured investment management process, the Zurich investment foundation seeks the best suited asset manager for each asset class.

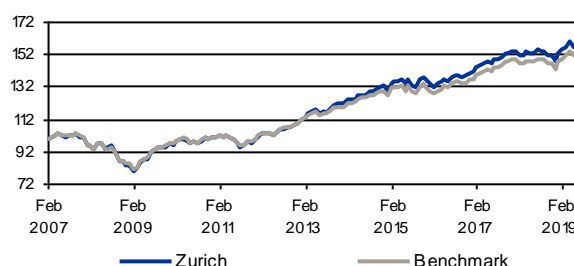
The initial selection criteria and the asset manager's performance are reviewed on a continuous basis. In the case of significant deviations, the selection process for the affected asset management mandate is restarted.

## Profile Progressive

The investment objective of is to optimize returns while maintaining a specific value fluctuation reserve. The strategies may include alternative investments in addition to traditional asset classes such as equities, capital market, real estate and mortgages.

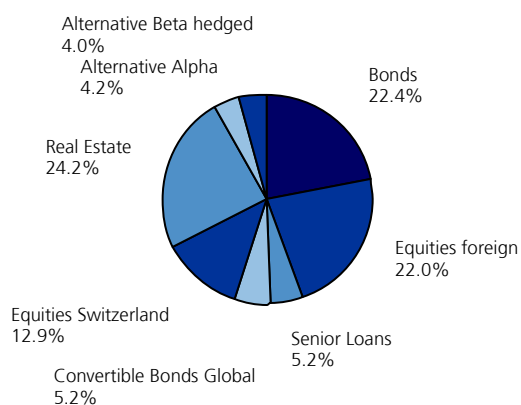
